1. The meeting was called to order at 4:10 PM
2. Approval of Minutes for April 20, 2012: Approved with a typo correction
3. Gen Ed course proposals
  - 3-1. **IDIS 350M** Experiential Learning designation: unanimously approved
  - 3-2. **HIST 190** Human Experience and Society designation: unanimously approved
4. Student Petition for General Education credit
  - 4-1. CH 104 and CH 105 for Natural Science requirements: Kristen Poland did not enough documentation for the Gen Ed. Committee to make decision on her case. The Committee decided to postpone this petition until next meeting after Jim Gaines talks to Kristen Poland's advisor and Dianne Baker consults with the chair of Chemistry Dept.
  - 4-2. BR 345 for Quantitative Reasoning: The Committee decided to postpone the decision until next meeting for the same reasons with her CH 104 and CH 105 petitions.
  - 4-3. Watercolor and Tempera/Gouache Techniques class at University of Florence for ALPP credits: The committee decided to recommend her to submit a request for re-evaluation of transfer credit with a copy of syllabus and other supporting documents after she finishes the course at Univ. of Florence
  - 4-4. WRLD/INTL 203 for Global Inquiry: unanimously approved
  - 4-5. Study abroad for Experiential Learning (retroactive): The Committee rejected the request for EL credit, as the student did not submit an approved contract for EL credit before he went to China for study abroad.
