Faculty Athletics Representative (FAR)
Job Duties and Description
Fall 2017*

1. Preferred tenured faculty or administrator with faculty rank.
2. Preferred experience with collegiate athletics.
3. NCAA-mandated position appointed by the President. Is one of five UMW reps who may contact the NCAA.
4. Ensure the academic integrity of the athletics program.
5. Monitor academic performance of student-athletes, including delivery of academic services.
6. Serve as liaison between the athletics department and the faculty.
7. Serve as senior faculty advisor on athletics to the President and Athletics Direct Report (at UMW, VP for Student Affairs). Meet regularly with President and ADR (at least 1/semester).
8. Provide counsel to the Director of Athletics. Meet regularly with Director of Athletics (1/month).
9. Serve as a member of the Athletics Leadership Team (1/month).
10. Attend regular Athletics staff meetings (1/month).
11. Meet with Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (1/semester).
12. Attend annual NCAA Convention (usually mid-January).
13. Attend Capital Athletic Conference meetings (1/semester).
14. Work with compliance director to ensure student-athlete eligibility.
15. Participate on search committees for senior athletics department administrators and head coaches.
16. Chair the Intercollegiate Athletics Advisory Committee.
17. Be visible to student-athletes and staff through attendance at contests, events, etc.

* There is a \$3000 annual stipend.

18. Nominate student athletes for national recognitions and/or provide letters of support for same.
