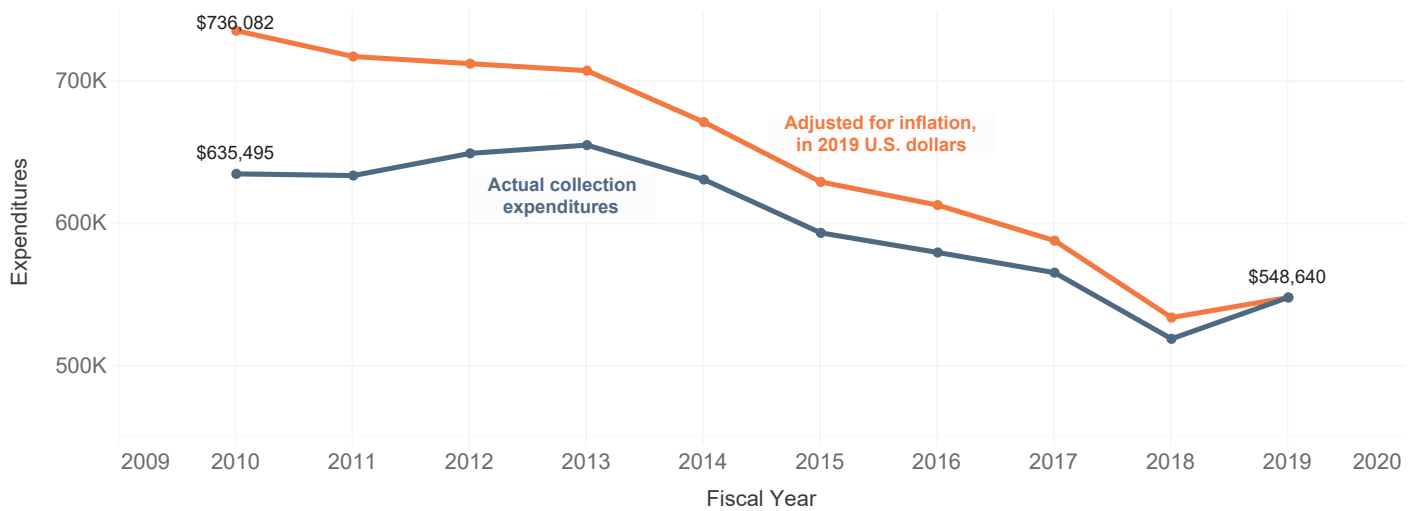


UMW Libraries Collection Expenditures

Overview of Collection Expenditures, FY10-19

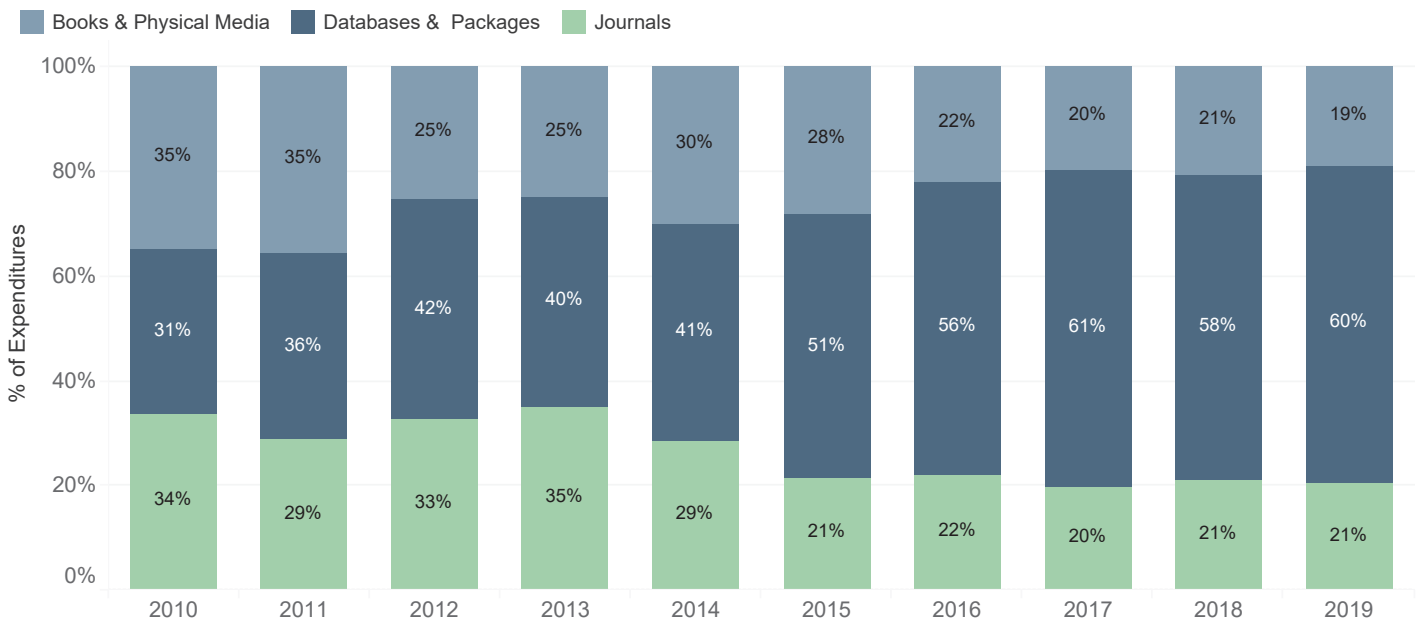
Over the past decade, spending on library collections, including books, journals, and databases, has decreased by 14%. When adjusted for inflation, this decrease is almost 25%.



Notes: These data were obtained from Banner. For each fiscal year, the year-to-date amount was recorded for the accounts used for library collections: 72221, 72222, 72226, 72227, 72228, and 72229. FY19 is the amount budgeted, not actual expenditures. The amount adjusted for inflation was calculated using CPI-W.

Percentage of Collection Expenditures by Resource Type

As a higher percentage of the collections budget is devoted to maintaining existing database subscriptions, less is available to spend on individual monograph purchases and journal subscriptions.



Notes: These data were obtained from Banner. Books & Physical media include one-time purchases of individual print and electronic books and DVDs (72221, 72222). Databases & Packages include annual subscriptions to databases and e-book, e-journal, image, numeric data, and streaming video collections (72227, 72229). Journals include individual subscriptions to print and electronic journals (72226, 72228).
