- I. Speaking Center Report**
  - a. Spring 2019 visits report
    - i. Spring less busy than fall
    - ii. 446 consultations (735 in fall), over 440 students reached during in class visits, 96 in workshops
    - iii. 1, 136 students worked with in some capacity
    - iv. Total for year: 3,339 worked with in some capacity
    - v. Still looking for a couple more consultants for Spring
- II. SI Report**
  - a. Advocacy, Deliberation, and Community Engagement Learning Community
    - i. Going to be expanded from the original 6 spots
- III. Request for Transfer Credit**
  - a. Two already approved (BUAD 473 and BUS 220)
- IV. Discussion of Offering Speaking Intensive Courses Online**
  - a. Has been offered as part of BLS program
  - b. A couple of others have done so as well
  - c. Discussion of concerns: concerns regarding how to conduct SI in the online class other than recorded speeches; different learning objectives for online courses as a possibility;
  - d. Should have to resubmit if moving online in order to be designated SI
  - e. Need to incorporate different expectations to meet the SI course objectives.
  - f. Potential Expectations: additional approval to go online with explicit explanations of assignment and resources; still three SI related assignments; at least two audio-visual component for student SI performance; and at least 1 synchronous
  - g. Considering hosting a workshop with some sample options, technologies, and assignments to help these considerations
  - h. Will need new submission form for this
  - i. Anand will work on these updates to send out before end of semester, then we can turn to the additional resources and workshops
