

Proposed Handbook language, if Community Engagement Committee is Created

2.8.13 Community Engagement Committee The committee consists of five faculty members appointed as described in section 2.7.2. The committee also includes the Faculty Director of the Center for Community Engagement as a non-voting *ex officio* member. The committee's duties are to:

- .1 Study and recommend to the University Faculty Council procedures and criteria for approval, deletion, and alteration of course offerings in the Community Engaged general education designation;
- .2 Review and approve or reject proposals from the various departments for courses to be designated community engaged;
- .3 Review at its discretion the frequency of offering and general relevance of courses so designated and make recommendations for changes as appropriate;
- .4 Make information available regarding the procedures and deadlines for proposing courses to the general education committee;
- .5 Review and coordinate support for community engaged coursework and pedagogy with the relevant centers and support units; and
- .6 Perform other duties consistent with its charge as assigned by the University Faculty Council.
