

Motion: Adopt the Credit/Pass-19/No Credit Grading Option in Response to COVID-19 for Summer 2020 courses.

Rationale: the Credit/Pass-19/No Credit grading option was developed for Spring 2020 to provide students with grading flexibility in recognition of the unique circumstances that were the result of the university's response to COVID-19. While students were aware that Summer 2020 courses would be offered online when they registered, access to campus resources and support are similarly limited in the summer as they were in the spring. Additionally, if we can anticipate a similar rationale for this grading policy to be applied in Fall 2020, then perhaps it should be available in Summer 2020.

Motion: Adopt the Proposal for Credit/Pass-19/No Credit Grading Option in Response to COVID-19 for Summer 2020 courses. This motion will provide undergraduate students with the choice of designating any of their courses to receive a Credit/Pass/No Credit in place of a letter grade. Credit represents a C or higher letter grade; Pass represents a C-, D+, D; No Credit represents a failing grade. Credit or Pass can satisfy general education requirements and major/minor requirements as stipulated in Spring 2020. The default in this policy is for Credit to count in majors and minors. A grade of No Credit will mean that the student will not receive course credit, the No Credit grade will not factor into a student's GPA (unlike a Fail would with a Pass/Fail grade), and a No Credit grade will count as attempted credits.
