Motion: AMEND - End of the Year Faculty Meeting to be Held Electronically

Rationale: At its March 25, 2020, meeting, the UFC approved a motion to allow for the end of the year faculty meeting to be held electronically. This motion is to amend the previously approved motion to allow for changes to its implementation. The amended motion allows for a Zoom meeting/webinar to be held on April 22, 2020, where much of the in-person agenda of the meeting can be held, including recognition of retiring colleagues. Approval of agenda items will still take place via a Qualtrics survey initiated after the April 22, 2020, Zoom meeting. Changes to the previous motion are noted in red.

Motion: given that UMW faculty are teaching and working remotely, the April 22,2020, General Faculty Meeting should be held electronically via Qualtrics survey with a revised schedule. The call for agenda items, including any faculty requests to revisit actions taken by the UFC during the 2019-2020 academic year, should be distributed on Thursday, April 16, 2020, with any submissions due by noon on Thursday, April 23, 2020 Friday, April 17, 2020. An agenda for the general faculty meeting, including the Endorsement of Candidates for Graduation, and any submitted motions, will be distributed on Friday, April 24, 2020 Monday, April 20. The General Faculty Meeting will be held via a Zoom meeting/webinar for discussion of the agenda and recognition of retiring colleagues. An email will be sent to all faculty, with a link to a Qualtrics survey that will include faculty information (to ensure a quorum), and the ability to vote on each item. The completed Qualtrics survey will be due at noon on Friday, May 1, 2020 April 24, 2020. Current Faculty Handbook quorum requirements will be utilized, with faculty participation in the Qualtrics survey recognized as participation. Results will be distributed as soon as possible after the conclusion of the Qualtrics survey. In order to allow for the timeline outlined herein, this motion also suspends the final sentence in Appendix M, M.3 MAIN MOTIONS AND INITIATING BUSINESS which states that "All members of the faculty intending to propose a motion must submit the motion(s) in writing to the Provost at least one week before the faculty meeting."
