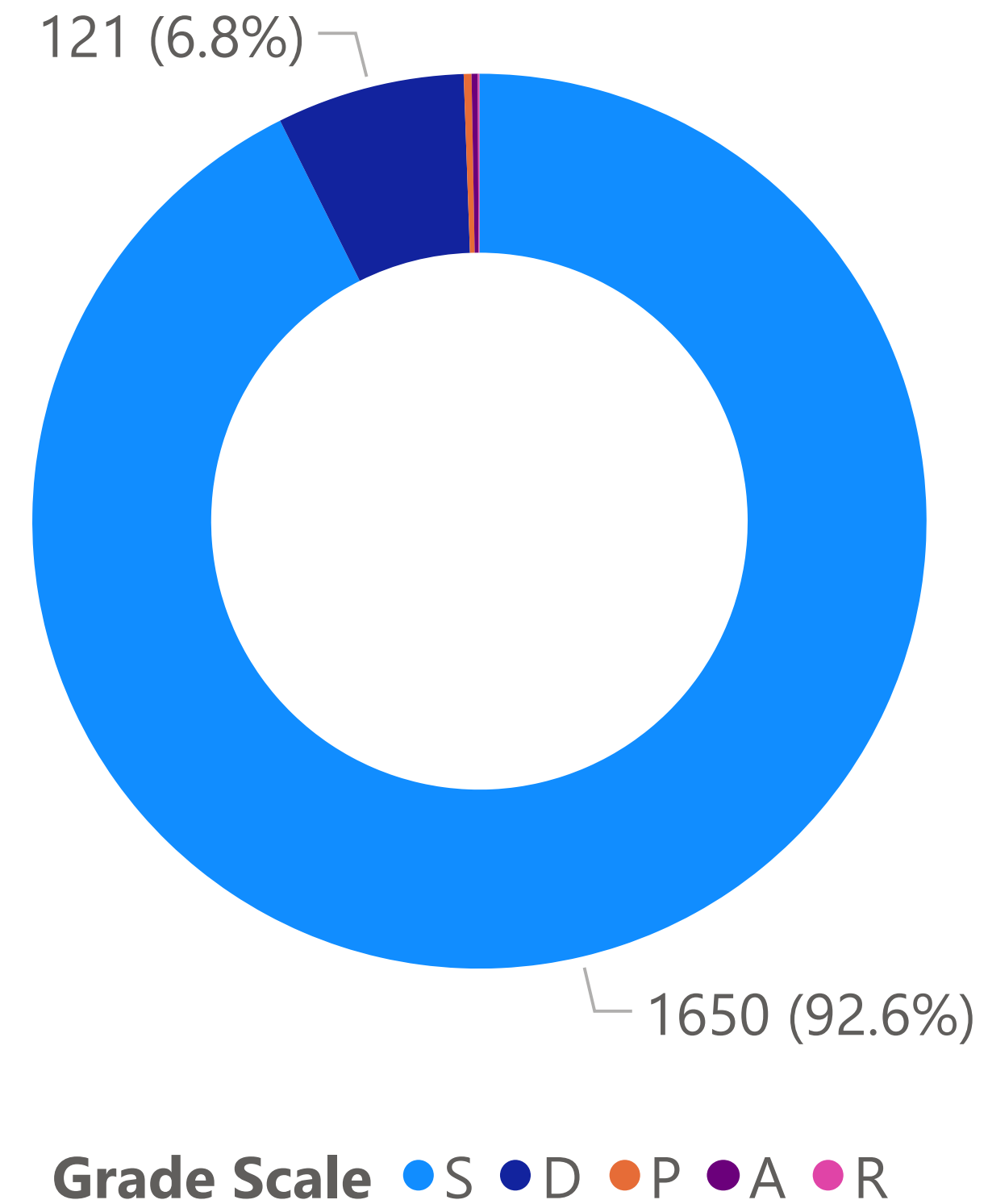

Among all enrolled undergraduate students, 92.6% of courses were graded in the standard A-F grade scale; 6.8% of courses were graded in the Credit/Pass/No Credit scale.

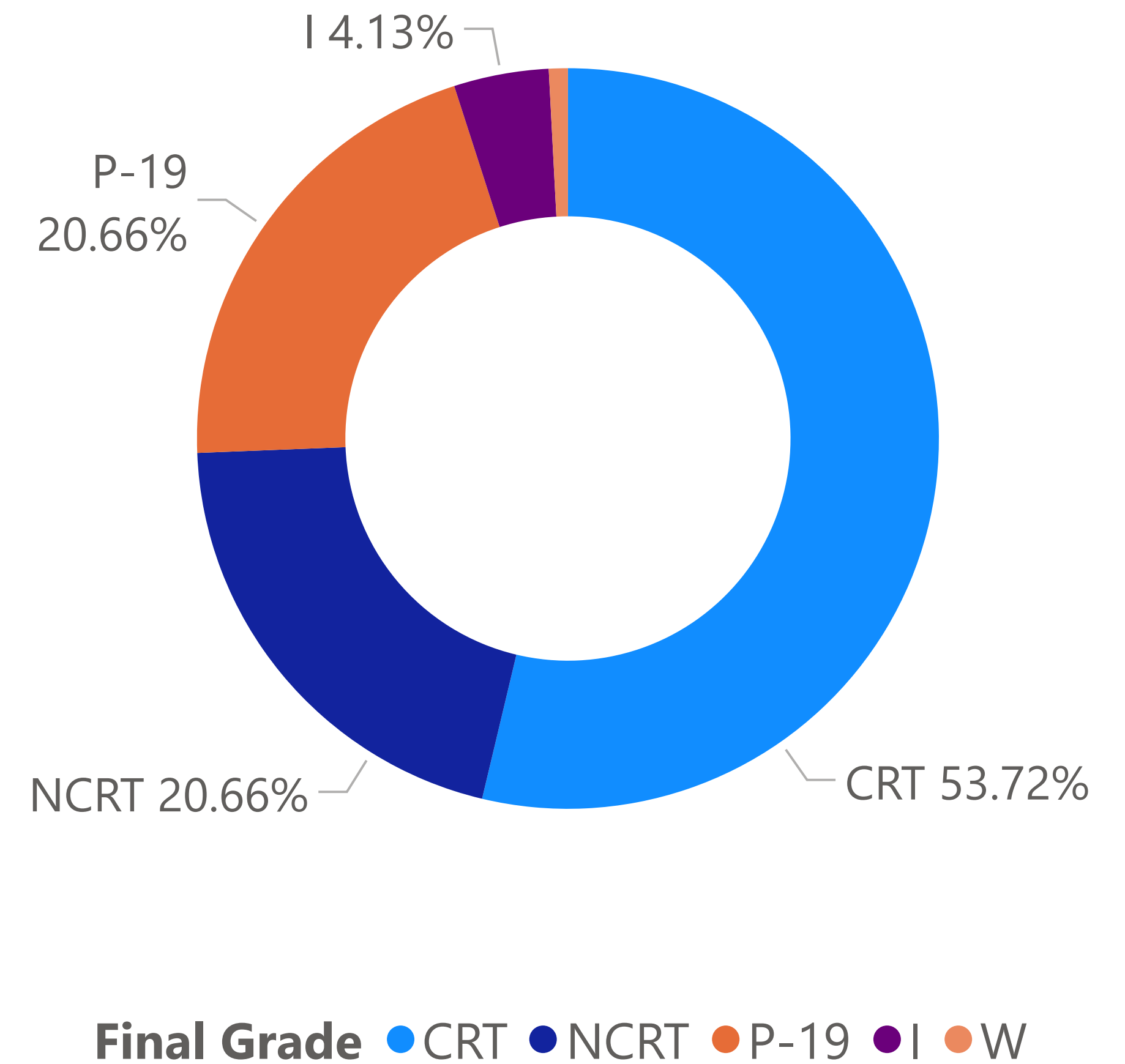

Students with One or More Courses in Alternate Grade Scale

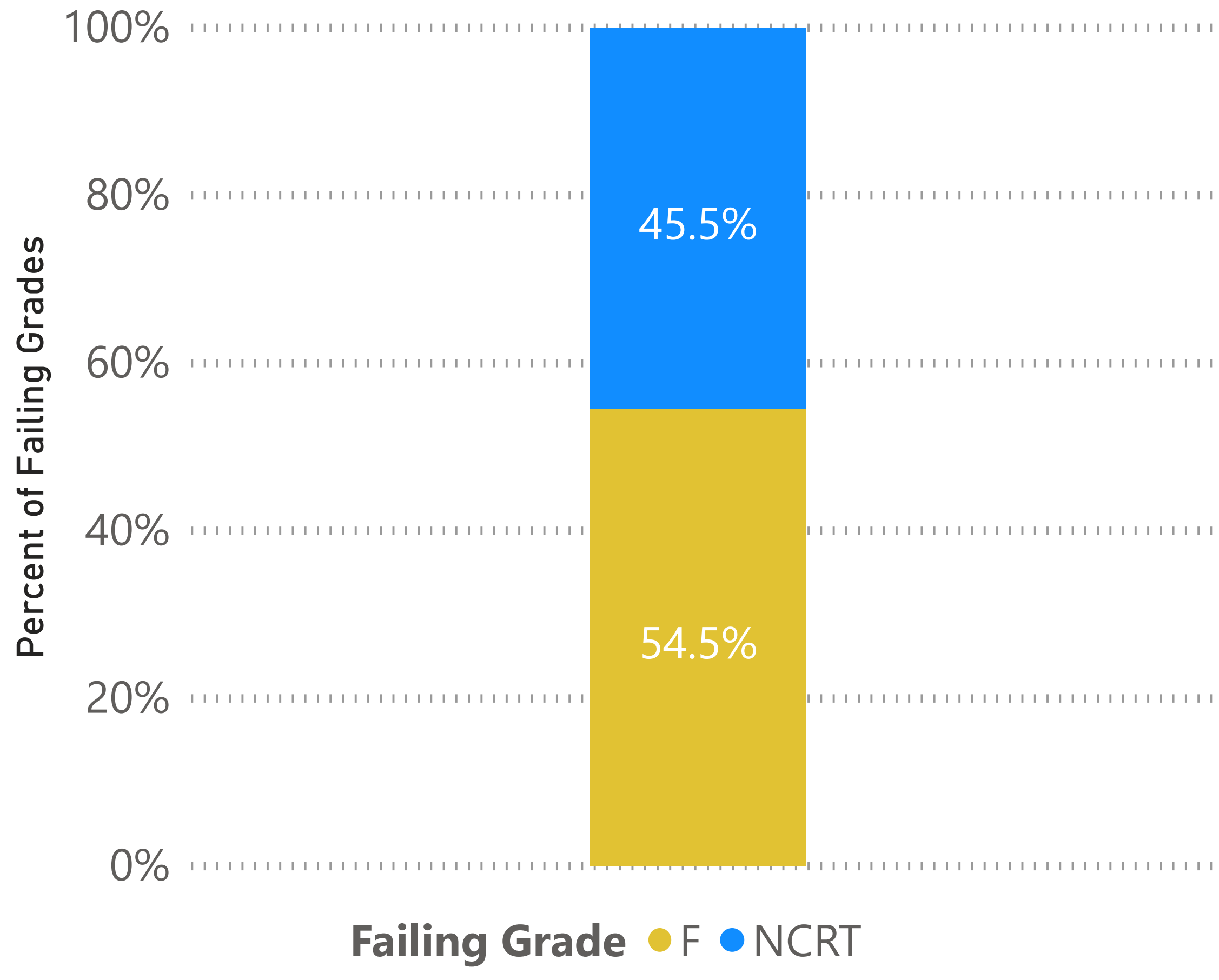
### Final Grades in Credit/Pass/No Credit Courses



Students who opted into the alternate grade scale earned passing grades (CRT or P-19) in 74% of those courses.

One in five course registrations using the alternate grade scale resulted in a failing grade (NCRT).

### Summer 2020 Failing Grades

Students Earned One or More Failing Grade

All students were granted access through Banner Self-Service (SSB) to review grades submitted by faculty prior to end-of-term processing, and were given 48 hours to adjust the grade scale.

Nevertheless, 54% of failing grades (30 F's among 24 students) remained in the standard grade scale, such that their failing grades negatively impacted their GPAs.
