Welcome and introductions of each member and Amy Filiatreau

Amy Filiatreau

- Amy is very new in the position, only here for 2 months. Currently learning about all budget issues and concerns.
- Library has not had much advocacy in recent years, lots of cuts in budgets and positions.
 - Example: When new academic programs have been introduced at UMW, the Library has not been given any resources to supplement the programs
- Biggest Request overall is salary of classified employees.
 - o Base salary is not competitive.
 - Many employees are being asked to add duties as positions have been lost and not replaced
 - There is a large turnover rate, possibly 50% of library staff.
- 2nd Request would be increased budget for books and new programs.
 - Libraries can be restricted from purchasing eBooks by publishers who want all students to purchase the books. There are also user restrictions with these eBooks
- Currently the Library does not have hard copies of all the text books that are required by Professors.
 - o Students regularly use the hard copies in the library in lieu of buying the book.
 - The texts available in the library do not always include the digital resources that are required by Professors.
- Security needs to be increased for later hours, already been examples or disruptions that should be handled by professional security.
- The physical building is in disrepair. Cracks on the walls are very prevalent and visible. It has been proposed that the Library will become a Capitol Projects priority for the University in the near future with either a cosmetic update or a full renovation. No definitive information at present.

- Tim O'Donnell is oversight Cabinet Member and has expressed interest in increasing the budget
- Previous leadership in the Library did not make asks for regular increases of salary and operating budget.
